This application must be completed with signatures and returned to the main office to be considered for a parking permit. Submitted application does not guarantee a parking permit, as student parking is EXTREMELY limited. Only after a parking permit is issued, can a student park in HHS parking spaces.

HHS Student Parking Policy

The following parking procedures are in effect as soon as the yearly permits are issued.

- No vehicles may park in Hanover High School parking lots between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (2:00 p.m. Wednesdays) without an approved parking sticker. Cars parked illegally will be ticketed and may be towed.
- Legal parking may occur only in designated parking spaces. There are clearly marked "Student Parking" signs behind the school, along the track fence and across from the turf field. **Please be advised that Hovey Lane parking is by town permit only.**
- Drivers/owners of vehicles that are illegally parked in school lots will be:
 - In the first instance, given a warning sticker
 - In a second instance, issued a \$40.00 ticket
 - Each subsequent violation will be subject to additional \$40.00 tickets and/or towing at the discretion of the Dean of Students
- The Friends Meeting House, the Lutheran Church, and the Senior Citizens parking lots are closed to student parking. Town parking permits are available for Hovey Lane. Please see the Town Clerk for more information.

The school reserves the right to restrict the parking privileges of students at anytime, including, but not limited to the following reasons:

- Transferring a parking sticker to any other student
- Providing false information on your application

Parking Applications

Students applying for a parking permit must have a valid license by the date of issue. All designated student spaces will be distributed to hardship students with a preference to seniors.

Hardship Students

Hardship parking is defined as a situation that is out of the control of the student. This burden would require a student to drive their vehicle to school in order to attend their classes on a daily basis. The following circumstances **DO NOT** apply for hardship:

- Co-Curricular activities (before or after school)
- Carpooling
- Students that have access to bus routes
